Costume Notes

Please find your role(s) and begin collecting your costume pieces early.

Cast members should apply mascara before arrival. All other makeup will be provided and applied at the theater before performances.

All cast members must wear something that they feel comfortable changing in with other kids around. Undergarments are necessary because everybody will change costumes in a large, public, co-ed dressing room. Please, no midriffs.

- Fitted undergarments (leotard, camisole, tank top, bike shorts, etc.) in white or tan colors to help to ensure nothing is bulky and seen underneath the costume.
- All boys must wear a white undershirt and light colored shorts which will be worn under the costume pants.



- Cast members might want a sweater/sweatshirt to wear as they come and go from the theater since costumes cannot be taken or worn outside of the theater.

Shoes & Socks/Tights

All shoes must be close-toed!

Those Playing Boys/Men: Need black or brown knee socks and black or brown dress shoes (leather style)



Those Playing Girls: Need to wear black or white tights and black, tan, or white dress flats. Jazz or ballet shoes are also acceptable.



Those Playing Women: Need to wear black tights and black dress flats or character shoes.



Hair

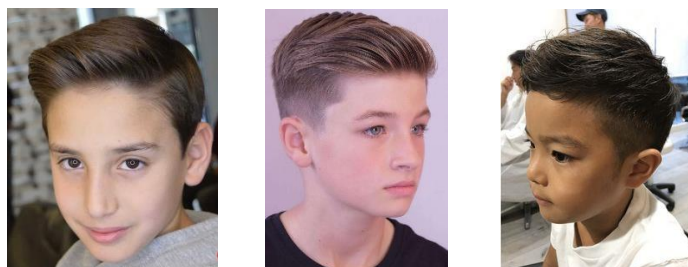
Hair for “adult women”: Hair should be put in a neat up-do. This can be a French twist, bun, or any style that’s up and out of the face.



Hair for “girls”: Hair should be half up/half down in curls or braided. It should be clean and off the face with no strands hanging down. Hairs bows will be provided.



Hair for ALL boys: Hair should be neatly combed. Although many boys are wearing hats, there may be times when they take them off and we want neat hair underneath.



Hair for girls playing boy roles: Hair should be in a single braid down the back that can be tucked into your shirt collar.
